WEEK 1 PRE-SEASON NFL SELECTIONS

BALTIMORE Over New Orleans by 11

This is a game with tons of situations that will point you into the direction of only one choice. Ravens HC John Harbaugh is the king of NFL preseason. There is no coach in the league that makes winning a priority during the preseason more than John Harbaugh. Also don't forget, Drew Brees has retired and the Saints QB rotation favors the Ravens. Harbaugh plays to win every single game, no matter when and where. Knowing this is cemented in the following. He's 7-0 SU/ATS ledger at home in preseason openers – and the Ravens 5-0 SU/ATS record in preseason openers when facing NFC South foes. Conversely New Orleans HC Sean Payton enters with a dismal preseason record. He's 7-14 SU and 6-15 ATS mark in his last twenty-one preseason games. Baltimore head coach John Harbaugh is 17-0 SU and 15-1-1 ATS in the preseason since 2016. Kinda hard to buck these trends and let's hope the trend is our friend.

Projected Score: Baltimore 24, New Orleans 13

Cincinnati over TAMPA BAY by 1

The defending Super Bowl champs have been money burners when laying points during the preseason, going 45-62-2 ATS since 1983, including 4-14 ATS since 2011. Tampa head coach Bruce Arians and his 4-5 SU and 3-6 ATS career mark when laying points at home in pre-season games. Arians most likely sits Tom Brady in this game. The Bengals have a new offensive line and will play a lot in the attempts of jelling before the season starts. Bengals are 4-1 SU/ATS versus NFC South foes in the preseason since 2011. Joe Burrow may get a quarter or so of play just to knock off the rust and test his recovery. Preseason favorites of a TD or more points is a tough nut to crack as they're just 5-10 ATS. Bengals should keep this one tight.

Projected Score: Cincinnati 17, Tampa Bay 16

WEEK 2 PRE-SEASON NFL SELECTIONS

ARIZONA Over Kansas City by 4

Super Bowl losers tend to struggle both in the preseason and regular season the following year – all while keeping in mind that should the situation arise. KC head coach Andy Reid has struggled in Game Two of the preseason, going 4-7 SU and 3-8 ATS since 2009, including 1-5 ATS if coming off a win. Reid has also struggled against NFC West division foes during these fugasi games, including 0-6 ATS when not taking points. Conversely we have an Arizona squad that stands 12-5 ATS at home when not favored in Game Two of the preseason. I'm backing the Cardinals at home.

Projected Score: Arizona 24, Kansas City 20

MINNESOTA over INDIANAPOLIS by 10

Similar to Ravens HC Harbaugh, Mike Zimmer's 37-16 SU and 36-17 ATS career in games against AFC foes, including 20-5 SU and 17-8 ATS in NFLX games, is very noteworthy. Last season's 28-11 loss at Indy in week 2 of the regular season started the Vikings into a tailspin that resulted in the Vikings' first losing season since 2014, the first year Zimmer took over as HC. Indianapolis has a dismal 9-25 SU and 10-22-2 ATS preseason log in non-division frays. The Colts' first ever preseason meeting with an NFC North division foe does not end well. Colts dealing with a serious QB situation with newly acquired starting QB Carson Wentz on the injury list. Viking HC Mike Zimmer is 9-1 SU and 7-3 ATS in a revenge mode off a loss against AFC opponents.

Projected Score: Minnesota 20, Indianapolis 10

WEEK 3 PRE-SEASON NFL SELECTIONS

Minnesota over KANSAS CITY by 7

Here we go again, jumping on HC Zimmers preseason accolades and more. Defending Super Bowl losers are 7-15 SU and 5-16-1 ATS in Game Three of the preseason since 1998, including 1-9 ATS when coming off a loss – and 1-11 ATS when facing a foe coming off a win. Then there is Minnesota head coach Mike Zimmer's awesome spread record in non-division games, preseason included, as we outlined in the Vikes-Colts clash in our week 2 selection. On the other side of the field are Andy Reid and his dismal 1-5-1 ATS mark with the Chiefs in preseason home openers. Once again, the coach is the key to this selection.

Projected Score: Minnesota 24, Kansas City 17

Chicago Over TENNESSEE By 3

The Bears close out the preseason with a revenge game from a 24-17 loss they incurred during the regular season on this field last year. What made the loss really sting was the fact that Chicago out-yarded Tennessee, 375-228. The hard-to-pass setup in this contest, though, comes from our well-oiled machine, as it notes that NFL teams who open the preseason with a pair of home games are 31-15 SU and 31-12-3 away in game 3 when facing a foe in its preseason home opener, including 26-9-1 ATS when taking points. Also kick in a 2-0 SU/ATS under head coach Matt Nagy. Vrabel cares less about the pre-season as noted by his is 0-4 SU/ATS record at home in preseason games.

Projected Score: Chicago 17, Tennessee 14

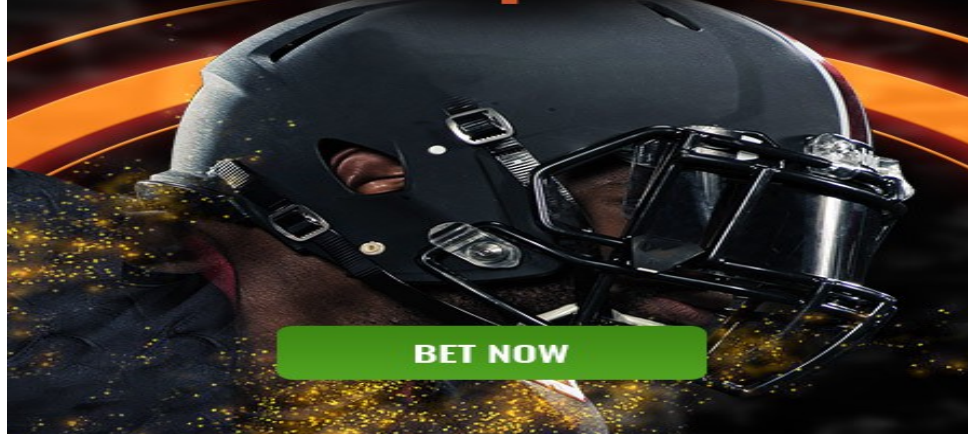
