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PACKERS WIN AGAIN, ONE MORE & THEY'RE IN

NFL Landscape:

NFL Week 17 winners and losers:

Week 17 no longer is the final slate of games in the grinding 18-week NFL regular season, but it turned into Elimination Weekend for an astounding five teams still hanging around the playoff picture.

The Washington Commanders, New Orleans Saints, Carolina Panthers, New York Jets and Las Vegas Raiders all watched their playoff hopes fade into the abyss on Sunday. That surprised one particular head coach on Sunday (more on that below).

Winner: Jalen Hurts OK, yes, the Philadelphia Eagles lost ugly to the New Orleans Saints 20-10 on Sunday. But they look incredibly lost without star quarterback Jalen Hurts under center. The Eagles' struggles in losses the past two weeks have put any takes that Hurts is a system quarterback to rest. Philadelphia can't move the ball without him on the field.

If Hurts returns from his shoulder injury this week and plays well in a win over the New York Giants to clinch the NFC East and No. 1 seed, he should be named the 2022 NFL MVP.

Loser: Riverboat Ron It wasn't a great week for Washington coach Ron Rivera. First, he opted to start Carson Wentz at quarterback over Taylor Heinicke, which felt like a decision based on Wentz's \$28.2 million cap hit than anything else.

When Wentz taking over the offense went as expected (not great, Bob!) and the Commanders fell 24-10 to the Cleveland Browns, Rivera apparently didn't know his team could be eliminated from playoff contention based on later results in the Sunday afternoon slate. "We can be eliminated?" he asked a reporter during his postgame press conference.

Sure enough, the Green Bay Packers stomped the Minnesota Vikings 41-17 to eliminate "Riverboat Ron" and the Commanders. At least Rivera was warned?

Winner: Aaron Rodgers The Green Bay Packers were 4-8 and had lost seven of eight games. Quarterback Aaron Rodgers was appearing on podcasts to rip his young, inexperienced wide receivers. Backup quarterback Jordan Love's music started playing softly in the background.

But then, of course, the Packers rattled off four straight wins to climb back to .500, their latest triumph being a convincing 41-17 drubbing of Minnesota at Lambeau Field on Sunday.

R-E-L-A-X. Rodgers can never be eliminated. He is inevitable. He is a cockroach who laughs in the face of repellent.

Winner: Detroit Lions On a positive note, the Detroit Lions whipped the Chicago Bears 41-10 to improve to 8-8 on the season. They can reach the postseason for the first time since 2016 with a win over the Packers combined with the Seattle Seahawks losing to the Los Angeles Rams next week.

Winner: Point differential Two teams in particular are having rather fraudulent records compared to their humble point differentials all season long.

Entering Week 18, the Vikings are 12-4 with a minus-19 point differential, meaning they have been outscored by 19 points this season. The Miami Dolphins, who were once 8-3 and threatening to overtake the AFC East from the Buffalo Bills, now are 8-8 with minus-7 net points.

Loser: Arizona Cardinals The Atlanta Falcons beat the Arizona Cardinals 20-19 in a game with no playoff implications that nobody watched. Just including it here so everyone knows.

Winner: Levi's Stadium The 49ers are starting their third quarterback of the season, a rookie picked last in the 2022 NFL Draft in "Mr. Irrelevant" Brock Purdy. They began the season 3-4 with humbling losses to the Chicago Bears, Denver Broncos, Atlanta Falcons and Kansas City Chiefs.

Yet, as the NFL regular-season schedule enters its final week, the 49ers have a chance to lock up the NFC's No. 1 seed. The NFC playoffs could run through Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara.

NFL PLAYOFF SCENARIOS

After the Buffalo Bills and Cincinnati Bengals battle tonight on Monday Night Football, it will be on to the final week of the regular season.

Several teams will have something to play for in Week 18, with some fighting for the last few playoff berths and others jockeying for seeding.

Ahead of what's sure to be a wild weekend of NFL action, here's what to know about the Week 18 playoff-clinching scenarios.

What are the AFC standings?

Kansas City Chiefs, 13-3 (clinched AFC West)

Buffalo Bills, 12-3 (clinched AFC East)

Cincinnati Bengals, 11-4 (clinched playoff berth)

Jacksonville Jaguars, 8-8

Los Angeles Chargers, 10-6 (clinched wild card berth)

Baltimore Ravens, 10-6 (clinched playoff berth)

New England Patriots, 8-8

Miami Dolphins, 8-8

Pittsburgh Steelers, 8-8

Tennessee Titans, 7-9

With the Steelers' last-minute win over the Ravens on Sunday Night Football, the Bengals can wrap up the AFC North race by beating the Bills. Should Buffalo win on MNF, the Bengals and Ravens would play for the division title in Cincinnati in Week 18. The Bengals are also still in contention for the No. 1 seed, along with the Bills and Kansas City Chiefs.

The Titans and Jaguars will play for the AFC South title in Jacksonville on Saturday night. Tennessee can only make the playoffs with a win, while the Jags would need some help in the event of a loss.

The Patriots control their own destiny for the third and final wild card spot, as a win over the Bills in Buffalo would be enough to clinch. A Patriots loss would keep the Dolphins, Steelers and Jaguars (if they lose to the Titans) alive in the hunt for the No. 7 seed.

What are the Week 18 AFC playoff scenarios?

Here's a full look at the AFC playoff-clinching scenarios:

Kansas City Chiefs Clinch No. 1 seed with: Win over Raiders and one Bills loss OR two Bills losses and one Bengals loss.

Buffalo Bills Clinch No. 1 seed with: Wins over Bengals and Patriots OR Win over Bengals and Chiefs loss to Raiders OR Win over Patriots, Chiefs loss to Raiders and Bengals loss to Ravens.

Cincinnati Bengals Clinch AFC North with: Win over Bills OR Win over Ravens.

Clinch AFC North and No. 1 seed with: Wins over Bills and Ravens, and Chiefs loss to Raiders.

Baltimore Ravens Clinch AFC North with: Bengals loss to Bills and win over Bengals.

Jacksonville Jaguars Clinch AFC South with: Win over Titans

Clinch wild card berth with: Steelers loss to Browns, Patriots loss to Bills and Dolphins loss to Jets.

Tennessee Titans Clinch AFC South with: Win over Jaguars.

New England Patriots Clinch wild card berth with: Win over Bills OR Dolphins loss to Jets,

Steelers loss to Browns and Titans loss to Jaguars.

Miami Dolphins Clinch wild card berth with: Win over Jets and Patriots loss to Bills.

Pittsburgh Steelers Clinch wild card berth with: Win over Browns, Patriots loss to Bills and Dolphins loss to Jets.

What are the NFC standings?

Philadelphia Eagles, 13-3 (clinched playoff berth)

San Francisco 49ers, 12-4 (clinched NFC West)

Minnesota Vikings, 12-4 (clinched NFC North)

Tampa Bay Buccaneers, 8-8 (clinched NFC South)

Dallas Cowboys, 12-4 (clinched playoff berth)

New York Giants, 9-6-1 (clinched wild card berth)

Despite two straight losses, the Eagles still have the inside track to the NFC East crown and No. 1 seed. All Philly needs to do is beat the Giants, who have nothing to play for, at home. An Eagles loss would open the door for Dallas to steal the division, and for the Cowboys or 49ers to claim the No. 1 seed.

One NFC playoff berth is still up for grabs with three teams in contention: the Packers, Lions and Seahawks. Green Bay controls its own destiny, as a win over the Lions at Lambeau Field would send Aaron Rodgers and Co. to the postseason as the No. 7 seed. The Buccaneers and Giants are locked into the No. 4 and No. 6 seeds, respectively.

What are the Week 18 NFC playoff scenarios?

Here's a complete look at the NFC playoff-clinching scenarios:

Philadelphia Eagles Clinch NFC East and No. 1 seed with: Win over Giants OR Cowboys loss to Commanders and 49ers loss to Cardinals.

San Francisco 49ers Clinch No. 1 seed with: Win over Cardinals and Eagles loss to Giants.

Dallas Cowboys Clinch NFC East with: Win over Commanders and Eagles loss to Giants.

Clinch NFC East and No. 1 seed with: Win over Commanders, Eagles loss to Giants and 49ers loss to Cardinals.

Green Bay Packers Clinch wild card berth with: Win over Lions.

Detroit Lions Clinch wild card berth with: Win over Packers and Seahawks loss to Rams.

Seattle Seahawks Clinch wild card berth with: Win over Rams and Packers loss to Lions.

Now all you have to do is remember these scenarios and you will be all set to make your week 18 NFL picks. Yeah right!

The Kansas City Chiefs and Las Vegas Raiders meet Saturday in week 18 NFL action at Allegiant Stadium.

The Kansas City Chiefs have won 4 straight games. The Las Vegas Raiders have split their last 8 games.

The Kansas City Chiefs have won 5 of their last 6 road games.

Patrick Mahomes is completing 67 percent of his passes for 5,048 yards, 40 touchdowns and 12 interceptions.

Travis Kelce and JuJu Smith-Schuster have combined for 2,198 receiving yards and 15 touchdowns, while Marquez Valdes-Scantling has 39 receptions.

The Kansas City Chiefs ground game is averaging 112.6 yards per contest, and Isiah Pacheco leads the way with 766 yards and 4 touchdowns.

Defensively, Kansas City is allowing 22.3 points and 331.3 yards per game.

Nick Bolton leads the Kansas City Chiefs with 165 tackles, Chris Jones has 13 sacks and L'Jarius Sneed has 3 interceptions.

The Las Vegas Raiders have won 4 of their last 6 home games.

Jarrett Stidham is completing 66 percent of his passes for 437 yards, 3 touchdowns and 2 interceptions.

Davante Adams and Mack Hollins have combined for 2,118 receiving yards and 18 touchdowns, while Foster Moreau has 32 receptions.

The Las Vegas Raiders ground game is averaging 122.5 yards per contest, and Josh Jacobs leads the way with 1,608 yards and 12 touchdowns.

Defensively, Las Vegas is allowing 24.2 points and 366.7 yards per game. Maxx Crosby leads the Las Vegas Raiders with 84 tackles, Chandler Jones has 4.5 sacks and Duron Harmon has 2 interceptions.

The Chiefs are 0-4 ATS in their last 4 road games and 1-7-1 ATS in their last 9 games overall. The Raiders are 5-1 ATS in their last 6 home games and 5-2 ATS in their last 7 games overall. The over is 10-2 in Chiefs last 12 road games. The over is 5-1 in Raiders last 6 home games.

The Kansas City Chiefs can lock up the top seed in the AFC with a win here, and we know they have the horses to blow the doors off opponents and that is exactly what I expect.

The Las Vegas Raiders put a lot of effort into last week's game against the 49ers just to come out with a loss anyway. With failed expectations, the benching of their quarterback and constant heartbreaking losses, it wouldn't shock me to see the Raiders come out flat and ready for the season to end. The Chiefs have had some close calls in recent weeks, most recently against the Denver Broncos in which they were a fourth down conversion away from letting the Broncos in position to tie this past weekend.

The Chiefs will be focused and playing hard for home field advantage in the playoffs. Although the Chiefs have played it close in some recent games, the safe bet is that they're going to take care of business on the road. The Chiefs are 13-6 ATS in their last 19 meetings in Las Vegas. Big number for a road team, but I'll lay the lumber.

The Tennessee Titans and Jacksonville Jaguars will battle for the AFC South title on Saturday night.

Yes, the division all comes down to this. If you had been told in late October or early November that Week 18 would decide it all, there is no way you would have believed it. The Titans were 5-2 after Week 8 and 7-3 after Week 11, while the Jaguars were 2-6 and 3-7 at those same stages. Well, Tennessee is now in the midst of a 6-game losing streak and Jacksonville has won 4 in a row (also 5 of its last 6 and 6 of its last 8).

The Tennessee Titans have split their last 8 road games.

Malik Willis is completing 50.8 percent of his passes for 276 yards, 0 touchdowns and 3 interceptions.

Robert Woods and Treylon Burks have combined for 912 receiving yards and 3 touchdowns, while Chigoziem Okonkwo has 29 receptions.

The Tennessee Titans ground game is averaging 124 yards per contest, and Derrick Henry leads the way with 1,429 yards and 13 touchdowns.

Defensively, Tennessee is allowing 21.2 points and 359.8 yards per game. Kevin Byard leads the Tennessee Titans with 103 tackles, Denico Autry has 8 sacks and David Long Jr. has 2 interceptions.

The Jacksonville Jaguars have won 3 straight home games.

Trevor Lawrence is completing 66.5 percent of his passes for 3,901 yards, 24 touchdowns and 8 interceptions.

Christian Kirk and Zay Jones have combined for 1,811 receiving yards and 12 touchdowns, while Evan Engram has 69 receptions.

The Jacksonville Jaguars ground game is averaging 131.1 yards per contest, and Travis Etienne Jr. leads the way with 1,108 yards and 5 touchdowns.

Defensively, Jacksonville is allowing 20.9 points and 355.9 yards per game. Foyesade Oluokun leads the Jacksonville Jaguars with 171 tackles, Josh Allen has 6 sacks and Andre Cisco has 3 interceptions.

The Titans are 5-1-1 ATS in their last 7 road games and 0-4-2 ATS in their last 6 games overall. The Jaguars are 6-2 ATS in their last 8 Saturday games and 4-0 ATS in their last 4 games overall. The under is 10-3 in Titans last 13 games overall. The under is 10-3 in Jaguars last 13 home games. The Titans are 4-1 ATS in their last 5 meetings in Jacksonville and 8-3 ATS in their last 11 meetings. The road team is 4-1 ATS in their last 5 meetings.

The Tennessee Titans are a wounded team that's piling up the losses. It wouldn't be surprising to see the Titans just roll over in this game and take off for vacation. The Jacksonville Jaguars clinch their second playoff berth since 2008 with a victory here, so you can expect a motivated side with a packed house.

It would wise to ride the hot hand here. The Titans are reeling, Ryan Tannehill is on injured reserve and Derrick Henry is banged up. Josh Dobbs has already been announced as the visitors' starter. Tennessee is 0-4-2 ATS in its last 6 overall and 0-3-1 ATS in its last 4 against the AFC. The Jaguars are 4-0 ATS in their last 4 overall and 5-0-1 ATS in their last 6 against the AFC. The Jags are firing on all cylinders right now, and that defense has allowed a combined 6 points in their last 2 games. Jacksonville keeps it rolling and they win the AFC South title in convincing fashion. Hello playoffs.

The Tampa Bay Buccaneers have split their last 10 games. The Atlanta Falcons have lost 6 of their last 8 games.

The Tampa Bay Buccaneers have lost 4 of their last 5 road games.

Tom Brady is completing 66.6 percent of his passes for 4,610 yards, 24 touchdowns and 9 interceptions.

Mike Evans and Chris Godwin have combined for 2,092 receiving yards and 9 touchdowns, while Leonard Fournette has 72 receptions.

The Tampa Bay Buccaneers ground game is averaging 76.4 yards per contest, and Fournette leads the way with 668 yards and 3 touchdowns.

Defensively, Tampa Bay is allowing 20.5 points and 320.7 yards per game.

Devin White leads the Tampa Bay Buccaneers with 122 tackles, Vita Vea has 6.5 sacks and Jamel Dean has 2 interceptions

The Atlanta Falcons have won 5 of their last 7 home games.

Marcus Mariota is completing 61.3 percent of his passes for 2,219 yards, 15 touchdowns and 9 interceptions.

Drake London and Olamide Zaccheaus have combined for 1,242 receiving yards and 6 touchdowns, while Kyle Pitts has 28 receptions.

The Atlanta Falcons ground game is averaging 159 yards per contest, and Tyler Allgeier leads the way with 900 yards and 3 touchdowns.

Defensively, Atlanta is allowing 23.1 points and 370.9 yards per game. Rashaan Evans leads the Atlanta Falcons with 154 tackles, Grady Jarrett has 6 sacks and Richie Grant has 2 interceptions.

The Buccaneers are 0-5 ATS in their last 5 road games and 2-11-1 ATS in their last 14 games overall.

The Falcons are 1-4 ATS in their last 5 home games and 2-8 ATS in their last 10 games overall.

The under is 11-5 in Buccaneers last 16 games overall. The under is 5-0 in Falcons last 5 games overall. The over is 5-1 in the last 6 meetings in Atlanta and 7-2 in the last 9 meetings.

Todd Bowles says he plans on playing his starters, but that could mean for a series or two. It doesn't mean they'll play the entire game, and frankly it would be stupid to with them locked into the fourth seed with no chance of improving. But we've seen stupid things before and on many occasions.

The Atlanta Falcons have been decent at home this season, and I'd assume they can beat the Bucs backups at some point. Once again, when will the backups get in the game and how long are the starters for Atlanta gonna play?

A lot of question marks about who plays or not, but when Todd Bowles says he plans on playing his starters, I believe him. And if you followed Tom Brady's career, he never wants to sit it out. Brady got the offense clicking last week, and knowing Brady, he'll want to keep the offense clicking on all cylinders going into the playoffs.

I'll take the free field goal, banking on Todd Bowles word and playing his starters for most of the game. Brady and the Buccaneers keep it going with a comfortable victory and cover.

The Cleveland Browns and Pittsburgh Steelers meet Sunday in week 18 NFL action at Acrisure Stadium.

The Cleveland Browns have split their last 10 games. The Pittsburgh Steelers have won 3 straight games

The Cleveland Browns have lost 4 of their last 6 road games.

Deshaun Watson is completing 56.7 percent of his passes for 872 yards, 12 touchdowns and 3 interceptions.

Amari Cooper and Donovan Peoples-Jones have combined for 1,906 receiving yards and 12 touchdowns, while David Njoku has 54 receptions.

The Cleveland Browns ground game is averaging 147.3 yards per contest, and Nick Chubb leads the way with 1,448 yards and 12 touchdowns.

Defensively, Cleveland is allowing 22.1 points and 331.1 yards per game. Grant Delpit leads the Cleveland Browns with 103 tackles, Myles Garrett has 15 sacks and Denzel Ward has 3 interceptions.

The Pittsburgh Steelers have split their last 6 home games.

Kenny Pickett is completing 64.4 percent of his passes for 2,209 yards, 6 touchdowns and 9 interceptions.

Diontae Johnson and Pat Freiermuth have combined for 1,576 receiving yards and 2 touchdowns, while George Pickens has 49 receptions.

The Pittsburgh Steelers ground game is averaging 120.6 yards per contest, and Najee Harris leads the way with 954 yards and 6 touchdowns.

Defensively, Pittsburgh is allowing 20.8 points and 331.9 yards per game. Myles Jack leads the Pittsburgh Steelers with 100 tackles, Alex Highsmith has 12 sacks and Minkah Fitzpatrick has 6 interceptions.

The Browns are 4-1 ATS in their last 5 vs. AFC North.

The Steelers are 17-7-3 ATS in their last 27 games in January and 5-1 ATS in their last 6 games overall.

The under is 6-0 in Browns last 6 games overall. The under is 4-1 in Steelers last 5 games overall.

The Cleveland Browns will be up for this game to play spoiler and dash any playoff hopes of a division rival, but it's not like they've been playing great and Watson is still clearly rusty.

The Pittsburgh Steelers are playing their best ball of the season and are firing on all cylinders, especially defensively. The offensive line is playing better in this streak and Najee Harris is running like he's possessed. Kenny Pickett is playing like a winner. The terrible towels will be out and the stadium will be rocking with shouts of "**here we go Steelers, here we go**".

The Browns would love to spoil the Steelers chances, but Watson's 56% passing will not get it done. The Browns are 1-4 ATS in their last 5 meetings in Pittsburgh and 2-5 ATS in their last 7 meetings. The home team is 7-3 ATS in their last 10 meetings. The Steelers have allowed 17 or fewer points in 6 straight games. There's still a path to the playoffs for the Steelers, so expect them to be fired up vs their hated rivals the Browns. I'll gladly lay the small chalk. **GO STEELERS!**

MIAMI - Pk Over NY Jets by 10

The New York Jets and the Miami Dolphins meet Sunday in NFL action from Hard Rock Stadium.

New York is 7-9 on the year and coming off a loss to the Seahawks. As for Miami, they're 8-8 after a loss to the Patriots in their last game.

New York was sitting at 7-4 in late November and had realistic playoff aspirations. Since then it's been a five-game losing streak for the Jets, however; they've fallen to the Vikings, Bills, Lions, Jaguars and Seahawks in that time.

In the Seattle matchup last weekend, the Jets were down 17-6 by the break. New York was outscored 6-0 from there and lost 23-6. QB Mike White put up 240 yards with two picks, and Tyler Conklin led the receivers on 80 yards from six grabs.

Over on the Miami side, they were 8-3 in late November with playoff aspirations of their own. The Dolphins also have a five-game losing streak right now: those have come to the 49ers, Chargers, Bills, Packers and Patriots

In their Sunday matchup versus the Patriots, Miami went into the second half with a 7-7 tie. The Dolphins were outscored 16-14 from there and lost 23-21. Skylar Thompson and Teddy Bridgewater combined for 265 yards passing, two scores and two picks.

The Jets are 5-0 ATS in their last five on grass and 9-21 ATS in their last 30 versus the AFC East. New York is 2-6 ATS in their last eight in January.

Meanwhile, the Dolphins are 5-1 ATS in their last six versus the AFC East and 2-5 ATS in their last seven on grass. Miami is 1-4 ATS in their last five after an ATS win.

The Dolphins still have an outside shot at making the playoffs if they win over Jets and the Patriots lose to the Bills. This is a very feasible scenario.

The Tua Tagovailoa injury situation doesn't help matters, but even without him I think Miami will win and therefore cover.

The Dolphins have played some pretty good teams during this five-game losing streak; the Jets will be a respite from that murderers row of tough teams. New York has scored a combined nine points in their last two games, and they've been below 18 points in each of the last four outings. I don't see the Jets mustering enough offense to do anything here.

On the other side, the Fins will likely be without QBs Tua Tagovailoa (concussion) and Teddy Bridgewater (finger) and will have to rely on 3rd-string QB Skylar Thompson.

The Dolphins have largely been in command across the last 10 meetings, winning 8, however, the Jets recorded a 40-17 victory when they met in Week 5 at MetLife Stadium. Miami had Thompson under center for that meeting too; he had 166 yards with 0 TD and 1 INT on 19 of 33 passing. New York relied on its ground attack that produced 135 rushing yards and five touchdowns. Michael Carter rushed for two touchdowns for the Jets in that game. Breece Hall rushed for 97 yards and a touchdown on 18 carries versus the Dolphins, though, he won't be there on Sunday as he is on injured reserve.

So by now, I think you can see where I'm going with this matchup. Unlike the Jets, Miami is still in playoff contention heading into this game, so expect the Dolphins to go all out on Sunday. I also think the Jets will want no part of that 80 degree weather in hot Miami. Expect a low scoring game (maybe an under play too?). My hypothesis is that the Miami Dolphins are playoff bound.
